Parent Statement of Understanding

The following information is important for the safety and protection of your child. Please read this information and sign below. (*RR represents RiverRat's Kayak and Canoe Rentals, LLC.)

- I understand that my child will not be released to any person(s) not listed on the enrollment form.
- I understand that my child will not be released to any person(s) who seems to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- I understand that I am not to leave my child at the RR's or program site unless a RR's Camp staff member or volunteer is there to receive and supervise my child.
- I understand that it is my responsibility to sign my child in the morning and sign my child out before leaving in the afternoon. **Sign-in/Sign-out sheets are available as you arrive at the program area.** (See other pick-up provisions in Parent Handbook).
- I understand that my child will not be allowed to leave the program with an unauthorized person. **Any person authorized to pick up my child must be listed on this form. Authorization by telephone will not be accepted.**
- I understand that the RR's is mandated to report any suspected cases of child abuse or neglect to the appropriate authorities for investigation.

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Statement of Authorization

1. My child has permission to be transported by a RR's vehicle and to participate in all RR's program activities and related field trips.

3. In the case that your **child becomes ill** during the program, you will be contacted as soon as possible. If the parent or guardian is unable to be reached, the child's emergency contact will be notified. It is the responsibility of the parents or guardians to arrange for the child to be picked up from the center as soon as possible.
4. In the case that your camper or anyone in the immediate household of the camper develops a **reportable communicable disease** as defined by the State Board of Health, it is the responsibility of the parent to notify the RR's within 24 hours or the next business day in order for the RR's to take proper action, except in the case of life-threatening diseases which must be reported immediately.

LIABILITY RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

In order to fairly and honestly inform you of the service we provide, you should know and appreciate that participation and/or use of any equipment during this trip involves certain specific risks and dangers which are inherent in river canoeing activities. These risks include loss or damage to personal property, injury or fatality, collision with an object, immersion in water, falling while onboard vessel or on shore, accidents or illnesses in remote places without medical facilities, and other unforeseeable events. There are no lifeguards posted along the river.

I, the undersigned, hereby acknowledge that I fully understand that there are inherent risks involved in river activities, as well as activities preliminary and subsequent thereto, including but not limited to the transportation to and from the river and camping. I expressly state that I assume all risks for myself and children in my care.

I understand that the rates quoted to me are based on my assumption of said risks, and that I specifically release the canoe rental, its officers, guides, agents and owners from any liability as to any right of action or claim to relief that may accrue to me or my heirs or personal representatives for any such personal injury, loss of life, loss of consortium, or loss of or damage to property, including gross negligence or reckless misconduct, which I may suffer on said river trip, the transportation to and from the river, or other activities associated with the trip. The terms hereof shall serve as a release and express assumption of risk for my heirs, executors, administrators, myself, and all members of my family including any minor accompanying me.

I further agree to be responsible for canoes, paddles, life vests, and/or other equipment issued to me; I will inspect said equipment prior to using it in order to determine if it is in a safe condition of repair and seaworthy, and I agree to return it in the same general condition. I acknowledge that I (and the children in my care) have received life vests and understand how they are to be used - If we do not understand, we will ask for proper instruction. Adults should buckle vests on small children. We require you to wear your life preserver and you acknowledge that each person in your canoe or group understand its' proper usage.

I authorize RiverRat's Canoe Rentals and its photographic agents to take and utilize photographs of me for the purpose of promotion and advertising.

I understand that alcohol and illegal drugs are not permitted while using RiverRat's Canoe Rentals' equipment and/or facilities.

I understand that I and anyone for whom I sign as a Parent or Guardian must be of the required age.

I HAVE READ THE ABOVE WAIVER AND RELEASE AND BY SIGNING IT AGREE IT IS MY INTENTION TO EXEMPT AND RELIEVE RIVERRATS CANOE RENTALS FROM LIABILITY FOR PERSONAL INJURY, PROPERTY DAMAGE OR WRONGFUL DEATH CAUSED BY NEGLIGENCE OR ANY OTHER CAUSE.

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2016 Camp Counselor Code of Conduct

In order for the RiverRat's Camp Program to be fun and safe, there needs to be rules. These rules will be strictly enforced:

- Use appropriate language – You are a role model to the campers, so remember eyes and ears are always on you.
- Show respect for all – You are an important support role in your group that helps both the counselors and campers.
- Keep hands to yourself – You need to set a good example, so we advise you stay away from any contact both in silliness and maliciousness.
- Report suspicious behavior – You are to contact officials if you feel that a child is or has been treated inappropriately at RiverRat's or outside of RiverRat's.
- Do not judge others or tease others – We have a zero tolerance for bullying.
- Participate – It is your job to make campers excited to be here and enjoy their day.
- Demonstrate a positive attitude – It is important that campers have the greatest week ever.
- Cell phones are to be used reasonably – You are not to talk excessively or check your phone excessively throughout the day.
- No risqué outerwear or swimsuits – Swimsuits should be appropriate for recreational activities. Undergarments should not be seen.

The rules of the RiverRat's program are to ensure that everyone has a good time and remains safe. If an employee of RiverRat's has trouble following the above rules, he/she will be referred immediately to the Camp Director. Camp Director reserves the right to suspend a RiverRat's employee at any time due to disrespectful behavior.
